Medication shall only be dispensed out of its original container which must be labeled with the child's name or as authorized under Georgia law. It was determined based on observation that an Epi-pen injector observed on site was expired and not in it's original container. In addition, the parental authorization was observed to have been signed more than two weeks prior to the current date and did not accompany a physician's note or allergy action plan. The medication was not dispensed.
