It was determined based on Consultant observation that closets were not locked containing one hot water heater, and several ceiling squares which poses hazards to children. in addition Consultant discussed to ensure that all locks work properly to prevent children from access to the storage located between the left rear classroom, and the right rear classroom.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.

Finding

Previously Cited: 591-1-1-.26(8) requires the playground to be kept clean, free of litter and hazards. It was determined based on observation that the entire outdoor play area was observed to be covered in leaves posing a potential hazard.

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that the following potential hazard was observed on the outdoor play area: -excessive leaves on playground

-one 4 foot high wooden board, and one 4 foot high wooden board

-fence not attached to ground base, causing possible entrapment

Previously Cited: To ensure the cleanliness, sanitation and safety of the playground, the center will remove the leaves.

The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
