- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the

program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined by a review of records that a staff member did not complete the fingerprint process when they were rehired at the center. During the virtual visit conducted on August 25, 2020 a staff member was observed providing direct care to infants and one year old children in classroom I. No other staff members were present in the classroom. When the staff member was hired on July 7, 2020, their portability period had expired.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

IMMEDIATE CORRECTION - The Center will create policies to ensure that every actual and potential Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center submit both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an authorized fingerprinting site as required. The program's owner or an officer/member of the corporation must view the A to Z Background Check video units pertaining to this records check rule and return the signed affidavit within one week from this visit date. The Center will follow procedures to ensure the CRC rules are maintained.

Finding

591-1-1-.09(1)(c) requires the Center to ensure that every Employee has a valid and current satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination on file prior to being present at the Center while any child is present for care or before an individual age 17 or older resides in the Center. The Comprehensive Records Check Determination must have a Records Check Clearance Date that is no older than the preceding 12 months of the hire date; provided, however, if the Employee has had a lapse of employment from the child care industry that lasted for 180 days (6 months) or longer, a new satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination is required. It was determined by a review of records that a staff member did not complete the fingerprint process when they were rehired at the center. During the virtual visit conducted on August 25, 2020 a staff member was observed providing direct care to infants and one year old children in classroom I. No other staff members were present in the classroom. When the staff member was hired on July 7, 2020, their portability period had expired.

Finding

591-1-1-.09(i) requires that for a Provisional Employee to become a permanent Employee, the individual must have a satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination. It was determined based on a review of records that a staff member present in the three year old classroom had a satisfactory criminal record check, but it was not electronically ported to the center. The staff member was observed during the virtual visit working in the classroom with another staff member who did have a satisfactory criminal record check on file.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

IMMEDIATE CORRECTION - The Center will establish policies to ensure that Provisional Employees obtain a satisfactory Comprehensive Records Check Determination in order to become an Employee. The program's owner or an officer/member of the corporation must view the A to Z Background Check video units pertaining to this records check rule and return the signed affidavit within one week from this visit date. The Center will follow new procedures to ensure CRC rules are maintained.
