<u>Comments</u>
The purpose of this visit was to conduct a monitoring visit and follow up on previous rule violations.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. Please see GBI's website located at http://gbi.georgia.gov to access the Georgia Sex Offender Registry.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

591-1-1-.25(13) requires that potentially hazardous equipment, materials and supplies be stored in a locked area inaccessible to children. It was determined based on an observation that the following hazards were observed accessible to children on this date:

In classroom 1L - a staff purse was observed to be stored on a low shelf, accessible to children.

In the front hall, the womens' bathroom was observed to be unlocked and two bottles of cleaning disinfectant were observed to be stored on the counter and accessible to children.

In the upstairs afterschool classroom, two cabinets were unlocked under the children's sink area, and one bottle of Oxyclean cleaner and multiple bottles of cleaners and disinfectants were stored accessible to children. In classroom 3L - one cabinet was unlocked under the diaper changing table and one bottle of febreze air freshener was stored accessible to children.

#### POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will identify all hazardous items and keep them in a locked area inaccessible to children. The Center will inform all Staff about hazardous items and the safe storage of those items.
