591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on consultant's observation that a hazard existed in that there was a gap on the bottom right gate of Playground B measuring seven (7) inches.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add a board at the bottom of the gate to enclose the gap.

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on consultant's observation that a hazard existed in that there were broken/cut limbs exposed at children's level in the walk way to Playground A and B. Also there were exposed tree roots on the path to Playground B.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will cut the exposed tree limbs and cover the exposed roots.
