If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. (O.C.G.A. Section 20-1A-4)

It was determined based on consultant's observation that the computer screens in classrooms E, F, and G were not secured to the table and could be easily tipped over.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on consultant's observation that there were sixty-two (62) bolts protruding more than two (2) threads around the chain link fence on playground A.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will turn all the bolts so that they are facing outside the playground.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on consultant's observation that there was chipping paint accessible to children on playground B around the red pillars, the red, yellow, and white canopy poles, and on the red fence between playgrounds A and B.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will pressure wash, sand and repaint the poles and fence.
