- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

O.C.G.A. Section 42.1.12(i)(2) requires Bright from the Start: Georgia Department of Early Care and Learning to notify licensed child care programs on accessing and retrieving from the Georgia Bureau of Investigation's (GBI) website a list of the names and addresses of all registered sexual offenders. Finding

591-1-1-.26(4) requires that playgrounds be protected from traffic or other hazards by a (4) four foot high fence or other barrier approved by this Department. Fencing material shall not present a hazard to children and shall be maintained so as to prevent children from leaving the playground area by any means other than through an approved access route. Fence gates shall be kept closed except when persons are entering or exiting the area. It was determined based on observation that the fence along the right side measured three (3) feet and eight (8) inches when four (4) feet are required. Further the back gate had gaps measuring six (6) inches to eight (8) inches when they should measure less than three and one half (3-1/2) inches.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add fencing to the side of the fence to maintain four (4) feet. Also, the center has contacted a fencing contractor to repair the back gate.

Finding

591-1-1-.26(8) requires climbing and swinging equipment to have a resilient surface beneath the equipment and the fall zone from such equipment must be adequately maintained by the Center to assure continuing resiliency. It was determined based on observation that there was zero (0) resilient surfacing from six and half (6-1/2) feet out when a total of twelve feet is required to the back of the swings and zero (0) resilient surfacing from nine (9) feet out when it is required to go out to twelve (12) feet in front of the swing. Six (6) inches of loose fill material is required to be maintained in this whole 24 foot fall zone area.

POI (Plan of Improvement)

The Center will add additional resilient surfacing to the fall zones of the swings, adding resilient surfacing as needed to maintain adequate resiliency.
