An in person Initial Licensing Study was conducted on March 2, 2021. The exit conference was conducted virtually on March 3, 2021 at 9:00 AM with the Director. Compliance with the Executive Order issued on February 15, 2021, was reviewed during the inspection and discussed during the exit conference.

This center was not granted permission to operate on this date. The center will be placed on a temporary license on this date. Consultant is still waiting on the following documents so that a permanent license can be issued.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

You have received permission to operate and the form received with this report is intended to serve as a temporary license which is valid for thirty(30) days. Your actual license/ will be emailed to you upon receipt of the licensing fee.
