An Administrative Review was conducted on September 8, 2021. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. An in person Initial Licensing Study was conducted on September 9, 2021. The exit conference was conducted virtually on September 10, 2021 at 1:00 p.m. with the Director). A Temporary License will be issued, upon completion of the Exit Conference and signature pages are returned to the consultant, pending confirmation on Fire Inspection. The overall capacity is limited to 75 children due to the number of toilets available to the children. Facility does carry Liability Insurance.

Received final approvals, issued Final Renewable License from desk on September 24, 2021.

 Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee
