- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





Important New Deadlines:

Due to the ongoing COVID restrictions, the deadline to become Quality Rated for programs who want to continue to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS), has been extended to at least December 31, 2021.

The provider and the Consultant discussed monitoring the playground daily for normal wear and tear of playground equipment and toys, Potential entrapment hazards in the fence surrounding the playground area, insects such as bees, ants, etc..., loose and or week tree branches surrounding the playground area, standing water in and around the playground equipment after inclement weather, and monitor the rubber mulch for normal wear and tear, and any tripping hazards.

Finding

591-1-1-31(2)(b)2. requires teachers and lead caregivers to meet minimum academic requirements and qualifying experience at the time of employment. It was determined based on review of records that staff member #43, date of hire September 16 2021, did not have evidence of an academic credential on file. The system reflects that the employee started working on her CDA 10/21. The director stated that a Variance had been submitted, but she never heard anything from the Variance. Employee #29 hire date October 6, 2021 did not have evidence of an academic credential on file. The Director stated that the staff is enrolled at Lanier Technical College, working on an Associates Degree in Early Childhood Education and will complete by 12/2022.
