- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

A child shall not be fed directly from the original baby food container if the contents are to be fed to the child at more than one (1) meal or to more than one (1) child.

It was determined based on a review of records that staff #17 was hired on December 1, 2021 and began work in on December 28, 2021 without a submitting fingerprints to an authorized fingerprinting site. The Center submitted the original application on October 12, 2020 but the staff member did not fingerprint until February 5, 2021 when a new application was submitted.

IMMEDIATE CORRECTION - The Center will review staff files and DECAL KOALA records to ensure that every actual and potential Director, Employee and Provisional Employee of a Child Care Learning Center submit both a Records Check Application to the Department and Fingerprints to an authorized fingerprinting site as required. The program's owner or an officer/member of the corporation must view the A to Z Background Check video units pertaining to this records check rule and return the signed affidavit within one week from this visit date. The Center will review the training videos and monitor staff files to ensure the CRC rules are maintained.
