- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

Staffing and Supervision

591-1-132 Staff:Child Ratios and Group Size(CR)	Not Met
Finding Associated with Complaint 591-1-132(1) requires the Center to maintain the required Staff:child ratios as follows: under 1 year 18 months if not walking = 1:6; 1 year and walking = 1:8; 2 years = 1:10; 3 years = 1:15; 4 years = 1:7; 20; and 6 years and older = 1:25. A Center must establish groupings of children for care with maxing group sizes as follows: under 1 year = 12; under 18 months/not walking = 12; 1 year and walking = 16; 20; 3 years = 30; 4 years = 36; 5 years = 40; and 6 years and older = 50. It was determined based investigation that there was a ratio of 1:19 when there were three infants, four one-year-old, four two-four three-year-old, two PreK, and two school age children present between 8:30 and 9:00 a.m., in the classroom.
