## **Technical Assistance**

591-1-1-.08(1) requires the Center Staff to maintain a file for each child while such child is in care and for one year after that child is no longer enrolled. In order for the file to be complete, the file shall contain the following: child's name, birth date, sex, address, living arrangement, name of school if applicable; names of both Parents, home and work addresses, and home and work telephone numbers; name(s) and addresses of the person(s) to whom the child may be released including address, telephone numbers, relationship to child and to Parent(s), and other identifying information; name(s) and telephone number(s) of person(s) to contact in emergencies when the Parent cannot be reached; name and telephone number of the child's primary source of health care; and a statement regarding known allergies, physical problems, mental health disorders, intellectual disabilities or developmental disabilities which limit the child's participation in the program.

The consultant spoke with the Director about ensuring that the program's new child enrollment application included a place for the parents to include the relationship to the child and parents for all person(s) to whom the child may be released. The consultant also asked that complete addresses are entered for any person(s) to whom the child may be released and that all parents include a statement regarding known allergies, physical problems, mental health disorders, intellectual disabilities or developmental disabilities which limit the child's participation in the program.

## Finding

591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on observation that there was a hole observed at the end of the wooden platform on playground B that presented a potential tripping hazard to the children in care.

## **POI (Plan of Improvement)**

The Director stated that she was aware of the hazard and had plans to add lattice along the bottom of the platform and fill in the gap to prevent trips and falls of the children in care. The Center will remove any litter and fix or remove hazards from the playground and will routinely monitor the playground and remove litter and hazards.
