An Administrative Review was conducted on September 20, 2021. Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. A virtual inspection was conducted on September 20, 2021 with the Director. An in-person visit was not conducted due to the COVID-19 pandemic.

Consultant requested to review all Criminal Record checks for all employees hired after last visit. Director provided one file for employees hired since last visit.

Plan of Improvement: No Plan Developed

  - All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
  - Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
  - Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee
