Staff files, children's files, training, and background checks were all reviewed. The Consultant completed the exit conference virtually and a copy of the licensing study/monitoring visit report was electronically emailed to the Program on October 14, 2022.

- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
  - New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee





#### Important Quality Rated/CAPS Update:

As January 1, 2022, child care providers must be Quality Rated to receive Childcare and Parent Services (CAPS). Newly licensed, or new to CAPS providers may be eligible for the new CAPS/QR Provisional Status, allowing for scholarships while working toward a star rating.

You have the right to refute any of the citations noted in this report with which you disagree. To refute a citation(s), do the following:

2) On the home page scroll down to the Inspection Reports and select 'Refute Citation' for the visit report in dispute

3) Select the specific rule number(s) that you are refuting, add the reason for disagreement regarding the rule citation, and upload supporting documentation

4) Submit the refutation in DECAL KOALA to Child Care Services (CCS) within 10 business days of the completion date.

If you do not have this liability insurance, you are required to post a notice with ½ inch letters in a conspicuous location in the program, notify the parent or guardian of each child in care in writing, obtain their signature to acknowledge receipt and maintain this written acknowledgment on file at the program at all times while the child attends the program and for 12 months after the child's last date of attendance. 591-1-1-.36(7)(c)2. requires that the driver or other designated person shall immediately document in writing, with a check or other mark/symbol to account for each child listed on the passenger transportation checklist each time a child enters and exits the vehicle. The driver or other designated staff person shall document in writing with a different mark/symbol to account for each child listed on the passenger transportation checklist who was not present on the vehicle for any reason. An explanation shall be documented in writing whenever a child is transported to a field trip site but is not present on the return trip to the Center. It was determined, based on review of records, that the driver or other designated person failed to document in writing, with a check or other mark/symbol, to account for each time a child entered and exited the vehicle for the following times:

•The afternoon routine transportation from Leadership Preparatory Academy to the Center was lacking the documentation in writing for the loading and unloading of one child on October 4, 2022.

•The afternoon routine transportation from Miller Grove Middle School to the Center was lacking documentation in writing for the loading and unloading of two children on October 4, 2022.

•The afternoon routine transportation from Mary McLeod Bethune Middle School to the Center was lacking the documentation in writing for the loading and unloading of two children on October 4, 2022.

The driver/other designated person will immediately document in writing with a check/mark/symbol each time a child gets on and off the vehicle.
