- New records checks will be required to be completed if a staff member experiences a six month break in service from the child care industry
- New clearance is required at least once every five years
- Any staff member solely responsible for supervising children will be required to have completed a comprehensive background clearance
- · All staff members are required to have completed at least a national fingerprint based clearance check
- Any staff member with only the national fingerprint based clearance, must be under constant and direct supervision of a staff member with a satisfactory comprehensive records check clearance
- Facilities are required to use DECAL KOALA for Criminal Records Checks, including to verify portability of an employee

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Summary Report

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The following information is associated with a Incident Investigation Closure:

Activities and Equipment 591-1-1-.03 Activities Not Met Finding Associated with Complaint 591-1-1-.03(8) requires a center to provide individual attention to each child by responding promptly to the child's distress signals and need for comfort. It was determined based on investigative findings that on June 12, 2023, a staff member did not respond to a child in distress or provide comfort when a child twisted their arm when they turned around on the carpet which resulted in a fracture. Correction Deadline: 7/6/2023 Facility 591-1-1-.26 Playgrounds(CR) **Not Met Finding Associated with Complaint** 591-1-1-.26(9) requires the playground to be kept clean, free from litter and free of hazards, such as but not limited to rocks, exposed tree roots and exposed sharp edges of concrete. It was determined based on investigative findings that on June 28, 2023, there were two active ant beds on the outdoor play area which resulted in a one-year-old sustaining four to five bite marks on their finger and arm on the toddler playground.

591-1-107 Children's Health Not Me
Finding Associated with Complaint 591-1-107(2) requires Center Staff to immediately notify Parents and obtain specific instructions until the child can be picked up or returned to the group when professional medical attention is required, or when the child experiences symptoms of moderate discomfort such as elevated temperature, vomiting or diarrhea and to notify Parents by the end of the day when professional medical attention is not required, when the child experiences symptoms of less than moderate discomfort or when the child experiences an adverse reaction to prescribed medication which does not constitute moderate discomfort. It was determined based on investigative findings that on June 12, 2023, staff failed to notify a parent that their five-year-old child had sustained an injury to their arm.
