The outdoor equipment shall be free of lead-based paint, sharp corners and shall be regularly maintained in such a way as to be free of rust and splinters that could pose significant safety hazard to the children. All equipment shall be arranged so as not to obstruct supervision of children. It was determined based on observation that the following playground hazards were observed on the left front playground:

- Three of five seats on the riding merry go round were broken and cracked.

- There was rust located on the top and inside of the red tunnel.

- There was rust and chipping paint located on the climbing structure.
