(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and the cabinet-designated database (ECE-TRIS) the surveyor noted the following:

- 1. Four (4) staff (hire dates: 8/15/01, 10/21/02, 3/18/11 and 2/11/13) had zero hours of early care and education training.
- 2. Two (2) staff (hire dates 1/13/17 and 7/11/18) had 1.5 hours of early care and education training.
- 3. One (1) staff (hire date: 9/15/99) had eight (8) hours of early care and education training.
- 4. Four (4) staff (hire dates: 6/5/18, 6/23/18, 7/10/18, and 8/20/18) had 7.5 hours of training.
- 5. One (1) staff (hire date: 7/11/18) has yet to complete the six (6) hour orientation training.

The surveyor reviewed online training certificates in personnel files; however; these courses have yet to be recorded in ECE-TRIS. It is important to note some of the certificates presented for review did not include a date.

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the surveyor found dates and times of Earthquake and Tornado drills, but did not find the names of the children who participated in the drills. The staff person in charge stated that she was unaware of this regulation.
