Staff hired on 07/22/13 and 08/04/14 did not have an updated pediatric abusive head trauma course on file. The course is to be retaken every five (5) years. General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1) There were several torn books in the two-year-old classroom.
- 2) The blue couch in the two-year-old classroom had several torn edges exposing the foam padding.
