Findings:

General: Based on observation, it was discovered in the Stage Area in use there were disinfectant wipes and a bottle of disinfectant spray within reach of the children. It was also discovered in the 4's Room and Tiny Town that hand sanitizer was being stored within reach of the children. Both bottles indicated that the products needed to remain out of reach of children.

- 3. Slide; and
- (b) Have a fall zone equal to the height of the equipment.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1) There was no shade provided over the infant/toddler area of the playground.
- 2) Around the climbable car play equipment, there was an inadequate amount of mulch serving as the protective surface. The mulch was sparse and is in need of being redone to provide a protective surface for the children on the playground.

- (1) All toys and furniture contacted by a child shall be:
- (a) Kept clean and in good repair; and

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the following was found:

- 1) In the 3's A Room, there was a significant amount of tape residue on the play stove in the dramatic play area.
- 2) In the Wobblers B Room, the mirror mounted on the wall was very dirty with smudges and handprints and needed to be thoroughly cleaned.
- 3) In the Stage Area in use, the cubbies used to store children's personal items had big chunks of wood missing and was in disrepair.

General: Based on observation, it was discovered that in the Infant Room the class refrigerator where bottles are being stored was at a temperature of 42 degrees and needs to be adjusted to be 40 degrees or below.

- (5) Frozen food shall be:
- (a) Kept at a temperature of zero degrees Fahrenheit or below; and
- (b) Thawed:
- 1. At refrigerator temperatures;

- 3. As part of the cooking process; or
- 4. By another method in accordance with the Department of Public Health's food safety standards and permits, established in KRS Chapter 217.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, it was discovered that in the kitchen, one of the freezers had a thermometer that appeared to be not working properly, making it impossible to get an accurate reading as to the temperature of the freezer.
