Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, the director was the only staff person present in the center with current first aid/and CPR certification on 08/16/17. Telephone interview with staff hired 2/4/16, determined there was no one present at the center with current first aid/CPR certification from 11:15 a.m. to 11:45 am on 8/17/17. Telephone interview with the director indicated she left the center to pick up lunch.

340 - Training **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, a caregiver hired 2/4/16, completed pediatric abusive trauma training on 7/12/12, but had no current documentation of completion. Caregiver hired 2/4/16, had not completed any training hours.

General: Based on Observation, spilled milk and spilled juice were on a shelf in the kitchen refrigerator. Also, there was an accumulation of ice in the freezer of the small refrigerator located in the infants' room.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the indicating thermometer was not operable in the freezer located in the resource room; therefore, a temperature device was not available to ensure frozen food was kept at zero degrees Fahrenheit.

- (a) A current immunization certificate for each child in care within thirty (30) days of the child's enrollment, unless an attending physician or the child's parent objects to the immunization of the child pursuant to KRS 214.036;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, a child enrolled 7/20/15, had a letter from the child's parent indicating his exemption from being immunized; therefore, the child did not have the required document pursuant to KRS 214.036. Also, a child enrolled 2/27/16, had an immunization record from Indiana, which did not have an expiration date.

- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

General: Based on Review of Documentation, two (2) children enrolled 7/20/15 and 11/16/16, did not list contact information for the preferred hospital.
