(3)(a) Each center shall maintain a child-care program that assures each child will be:

- 1. Provided with adequate supervision at all times by a qualified staff person who:
- a. Ensures the child is within scope of vision and range of voice; or
- b. For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;

### Findings:

General: Based on Observation and interview, upon entry into the center at 1:10 p.m., all three (3) present caregivers sat in the front room with a preschool-aged child. This left thirteen (13) sleeping children alone and unsupervised in three (3) pitch-black rooms. Interviews with the caregivers revealed they each were on a break and were placing lunch orders with one (1) of the caregivers at the time the children were alone and unsupervised. Three (3) children slept alone and unsupervised in a pitch-black room for three (3) minutes in the three, four and five year olds' room. Six (6) children slept alone and unsupervised in a pitch-black room for three (3) minutes in the two and three year olds' room. Four (4) children slept alone and unsupervised in a pitch black room for three (3) minutes in the infants'/toddlers' room. Interview with a caregiver determined children slept in a pitch-black rooms, during naptime, on a daily basis. Also, a child had a bowel movement, which leaked onto a mattress, while unsupervised in the infant/toddlers' room. The caregiver stated she discovered the feces when she returned from a break with the other caregivers in the front room, which was about approximately three (3) minutes later.
