- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

## Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a caregiver hired on 3/1/16, had no orientation training. A caregiver hired on 3/14/16, completed orientation training on 9/10/16. A director hired on 12/2/10, lacked ten and a half (10 1/2) hours of training. Also, a caregiver hired on 12/2/10 lacked thirteen and a half (13 1/2) hours of training.

General: Based on Observation, there were twelve (12) children present in the two-year-olds' room. The two-year-olds' room measured at 246.62 square feet which allows for seven (7) children to be present in the two-year-olds' room.

### Findings:

General: Based on Observation, there was no protective surface underneath a maroon and blue Little Tikes Slide, a yellow and blue Little Tikes Slide, a yellow, green, and red Little Tikes slide, and an orange, yellow, and green Little Tikes Climbing Cube in the outdoor play area.

General: Based on Observation, two (2) exposed screws had sharp tips and two (2) screw heads were exposed on a diaper changing table in the two-year-olds' room. An alphabet area rug had small dirt particles in the four-year-olds' room.

### Findings:

General: Based on Observation, Pairie Farms orange drink was served to twelve (12), three to five year old children during the lunch meal. Milk was not served.

#### **Findings**

General: Based on Review of Documentation, two (2) children enrolled on 6/13/16 and 11/7/16, had no immunization certificate on file. Also, a child enrolled on 4/4/16, had an "immunization listing", but not a certificate on file.

- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency situation involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

### Findings:

General: Based on Observation, ten (10) children enrolled on 3/24/14, 6/13/16, 9/14/15, 7/22/15, 9/25/15, 9/1/15, 2/3/15, 9/20/15, 4/4/16, and 11/7/16, had no preferred hospital listed in their enrollment information. Also, three (3) children enrolled on 9/1/15, 9/20/15, and 11/7/16, did not have their physician's phone number.

Also, five (5) parents did not include their signature on the daily attendance record dated for the week of 11/11/16, and six (6) parents for the week of 10/31/16.
