General: Based on review of documentation, staff members hired on 08/30/19, 08/01/10, and 10/22/18, did not have documentation on file from a health care professional stating they were each free of active tuberculosis.

General: Based on review of documentation, there was no current staff member who was CPR/First Aid certified at the time of the inspection. Each staff members CPR/First Aid certification expired in October 2021.

General: Based on review of documentation, there was no staff members who received fifteen (15) hours of cabinet approved training between 07/01/2020 and 06/30/2021. This formation was verified through ECE-TRIS.
