General: Based on Review of Documentation, two (2) substitutes each hired on 11/1/17, had no documentation a child abuse and neglect check was submitted timely. Also, a caregiver hired on 10/30/17, had no documentation a child abuse and neglect check was submitted timely.

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a substitute hired on 11/1/17, and a caregiver hired on 10/30/17, had no negative tuberculin results on file.

340 - Training Not In Compliance

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

General: Based on Review of Documentation, a caregiver hired on 8/12/13, lacked four and a half (4 1/2) hours of training. Also, a caregiver hired on 10/1/16, lacked three (3) hours of training.

General: Based on Observation, a gate to the playground fence was not secured to the top of the terminal post; therefore, the gate would not properly latch and was unstable.

General: Based on Observation, a yellow metal car-shaped play apparatus was rusty with flaky paint in the outdoor play area. The raw edges of two (2) handle bars were exposed due to the missing rubber covers on a turquoise four (4) seat bouncer in the outdoor play area. Also, there was rust at the end of the handle bars.
