922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, a staff, hired on 6/29/20, and a staff, hired on 7/29/20, did not have education verification on file.

395 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, a child enrolled 7/29/19, did not have information on file for staff in charge to contact the child's preferred hospital and physician and did not have authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in parent's absence.

General: Based on interview, a former staff member's personnel file was not maintained on file at the center.

1250 - Emergency Regulation 922 KAR 2:400E. Emergency Regulation.

Due to the current declared public health emergency caused by the Novel Coronavirus Disease (COVID-19), licensed child care centers must operate under Centers for Disease Control and Prevention and public health guidelines, as mandated by 922 KAR 2:400E, to prevent the spread of COVID-19.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, the center failed to assure new staff shall undergo name-based background in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280 and shall not be left alone with children until name-based background checks have been approved and returned, in accordance with 922 KAR 2:400E Section 9(5). A staff hired 7/29/20, did not have a processed child abuse/neglect check on file and was left alone and supervised six (6), three (3) and four (4) year old children for ten (10) minutes in the three and four-years'-old room.
