- (1) A person who is a child care staff member prior to January 1, 2018, shall submit to and complete background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation no later than September 30, 2018.
- (2) A child care staff member hired on or after April 1, 2018, shall:
- (a) Have completed the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation and been found to have no disqualifying offense prior to becoming a child care staff member; or
- (b)1. Have submitted to the background checks required in accordance with this administrative regulation;
- 2. Not be left unsupervised with a child in care pending the completion of the background checks in accordance with this administrative regulation: and
- 3. Be dismissed or relocated from the residence if the person is found to have a disqualifying background check result.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with the regulatory requirements regarding background checks. A staff member with a hire date of 10/01/18 did not have any Child Care Central Registry Check (CRC) in her personnel file nor any submitted fingerprints to an authorized collection site for the Kentucky NBCP. In addition, a staff member with a hire date of 10/09/2018 did not have a CRC in her personnel file nor any submitted fingerprints to an authorized collection site for the Kentucky NBCP. Furthermore, the director advised that she was aware that no CRC nor any submitted fingerprints to an authorized collection site for the Kentucky NBCP had been completed on the staff member with a hire date of 10/01/18. Moreover, the director advised that the staff member with a hire date 10/09/2018 had worked for another daycare center, and the director planned to have the submitted fingerprints to an authorized collection site for the Kentucky NBCP transferred in the Early Care and Education Training Records Information System (ECE-TRIS) transferred the child care center.

Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center failed to comply with staffing requirements. At approximately 9:45am, in the classroom known as the Pre-K room, twenty-one (21) children, ranging from three (3) years of age to seven (7) years of age, were observed. In addition, there was only one (1) staff member, with a hire date of 10/01/2018, who was supervising the children until 10:00 am, when another staff member, with a hire date of 09/19/2013, accompanied the sole staff member for the remainder of the survey with supervising the classroom, which ended at approximately 1:00 pm. Furthermore, from observation, there was no clear delineation in what age groups the two (2) above mentioned staff members were responsible for supervising. From the period of 10:00 am through 1:00 pm, all of the children were observed moving about freely and interminaling freely among each other on a constant basis. Moreover, the director acknowledged that child care center was having staffing issues due to several staff members calling in sick for the day. Consequently, the child care center failed to maintain the minimum staff-to-child ratios and maximum group sizes based upon ages repeatedly throughout the survey.

General: Based on observation and interview, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. There was a very large wooden fence enclosing the outside playground area. However, the wooden fence was structurally weak in many areas and some of the wooden boards were dry rotted and missing.

360 - Caregiver Alone **Not In Compliance**

- (n) Assure that a person acting as a caregiver of a child in care shall not be left alone with a child, if the licensee has not received the results of the background checks as described in 922 KAR 2:280;

Findings:

General: Based on observation, review of documentation and interview, the child care center director failed to assure compliance with regulatory requirements. From 9:45am through 10:00am, in the classroom known as the Pre-K room, twenty-one (21) children, ranging from three (3) years of age to seven (7) years of age, were observed being supervised solely by a staff member, with a hire date of 10/01/2018. A review of the above-mentioned staff member's personnel file revealed there was no Child Care Central Registry Check (CRC) in her personnel file nor any submitted fingerprints to an authorized collection site for the Kentucky National Background Check Program (NBCP). Furthermore, the director advised that she was aware that no CRC nor any submitted fingerprints to an authorized collection site for the Kentucky NBCP had been completed on the staff member with a hire date of10/01/18.

From the period of 9:47 am through 1:00 pm, in the classroom known as the One-Year Old room, a sole staff member with a hire date of 10/09/2018 was observed supervising five (5) children who were all one-years of age. A review of the above-mentioned staff member's personnel file revealed there was no CRC in her personnel file nor any submitted fingerprints to an authorized collection site for the Kentucky NBCP. Furthermore, the director advised that the staff member with a hire date 10/09/2018 had worked for another daycare center, and the director planned to have the submitted fingerprints to an authorized collection site for the Kentucky NBCP transferred in the Early Care and Education Training Records Information System (ECE-TRIS) transferred the child care center.

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulations. In the classroom known as the Two-Year-Old room, there was chipped paint on the walls. In addition, chipped paint was observed on the walls of the classroom known as the Pre-K room.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain the premises in accordance with regulations. In the classroom known as the Pre-K room, at 10:03 am, the bathroom toilet was unflushed and contained urine. In addition, in the bathroom located directly across from the classroom known as the One-Year Old room, 10:33 am, the toilet was unflushed and contained urine.
