Upon request, the child care director did not present verification of the evaluations assessing the staff person's interaction with children in care and classroom performance for the employees with the hire dates of 08/28/2013, 09/06/2013, 04/12/2014, 07/01/2015 and 10/01/2018.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, the child care center failed to maintain employee records in accordance with regulatory requirements. Upon request, the child care director did not present verification that the record for the employees with the hire dates of 09/17/2013 and 09/19/2013 contained evidence that they had met the requirement of updating pediatric abusive head trauma training. Review of documentation in the ECE-TRIS training system revealed the staff members listed above had not met the requirement.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the child care center failed to maintain equipment in accordance with regulatory requirements. Observation of four (4) cribs in the infant classroom revealed the sheets had excessive material. Therefore, the sheets were not tight-fitted to the mattress.
