(3)(a) Each center shall maintain a child-care program that assures each child will be:

- 1. Provided with adequate supervision at all times by a qualified staff person who:
- a. Ensures the child is within scope of vision and range of voice; or
- b. For a school-age child, within scope of vision or range of voice;

### Findings:

General: Based on Observation, upon arrival at the facility on 6/21/17 a tour of the facility was taken. During that time there were ten (10) three-year-old children unsupervised in a classroom at the front of the building. The surveyor observed a staff person standing in the hallway by a food cart. This staff person then walked down the hall to classroom where the surveyor was standing. The surveyor asked the staff person if she was responsible for the classroom and the staff person stated yes. In another room located beside the office there were sixteen (16) children ages two to five (2-5) years old. As the surveyor approached the room the staff person responsible for the group was walking into the room. There was not another staff person in the room indicating the group had been left unsupervised. An interview with the staff person found she had gone to the kitchen to get a can of pinapple.

General: Based on Observation, at the time of the visit conducted on 6/21/17 in a room located beside the office there were sixteen (16) children ages two to five (2-5) years old. As the surveyor approached the room the staff person responsible for the group was walking into the room. There was not another staff person in the room indicating the group had been left unsupervised and were over the staff to child ratio by six (6) children with the age of the youngest child being two-years-old.
