General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that a staff person with a hire date of 04/01/2017 had not evidence of being free of TB in her staff file.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that from 6:30am until 7:00am, there are no staff present in the facility with CPR/First Aid. A review of the staff schedule found that the two (2) staff that have CPR/First Aid do not arrive to the facility until 7:00am. The staff in charge stated that he would change his schedule to 6:30am since he has CPR/First Aid.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found through a review of eleven (11) staff files that three (3) staff files did not contain the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. The dates of hire for the staff were 12/23/2015, 10/01/2015 and 12/21/2015. A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed this. It was also found that a staff person with a hire date of 08/01/2017 had no evidence of completing the six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment. A review of ECE-TRIS also confirmed this.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that there was no program of activities for the four to five (4 - 5) year old classroom. It was also found in an interview that the infant children in the infant classroom are required to take a nap from 9:00am until 9:30am and again from 12:00pm until 12:30pm. In an interview with a staff person, she stated that she is trying to prepare her children for a nap schedule that will be used in their next classroom. One child was observed to be laying in a bouncer tossing and turning and crying and screaming.

General: Based on Observation, it was found that in the kitchen, that the door was open and that there were several sharp knives in an unlocked drawer that was accessible to the children. Additionally, two (2) containers of Bissell carpet cleaner, a can of Cascade, a jug of disinfectant and a jug of bleach all accessible in an unlocked cabinet under the sink.
