- (5) An individual described in subsection (4) of this section shall:
- (a) Submit to background checks described in paragraph (b) of this subsection;
- (b) May be employed or work with a child on a probationary basis for up to ninety (90) calendar days, pending completion of a:
- 1. Child abuse or neglect check using the central registry in accordance with 922 KAR 1:470;
- 2. Criminal records check required by KRS 199.896(19);
- 3. Criminal records check for any previous state of residence if the person resided outside the state of Kentucky in the last five (5) years; and

- 4. An address check of the Sex Offender Registry; and
- (c) Not be left alone in the presence of a child until copies of the background checks in accordance with paragraph (b) of this subsection have been received by the licensee.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that a staff person with a hire date of 04/03/2017 had a child abuse and neglect check with an unknown submission date. The child abuse and neglect check was not received until 05/01/2017. In an interview with the staff in charge, she stated that she did not write the submission date down and did not know when the form was sent off.

320 - TB Verification Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that a staff person with a hire date of 05/22/2015 had no evidence of being free of TB.

340 - Training Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:110. Section 5. Staff Requirements.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that a staff person with a hire date of 08/17/2016 did not complete the six (6) hours of orientation training until 06/01/2017. A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed this. It was also found that a staff person with a hire date of 11/09/2015 did not have the fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training. A review of ECE-TRIS confirmed this.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, it was found that in the two (2) year-old classroom, there were two (2) one-year-olds mixed with four (4) two-year-olds. In an interview with the staff, she stated that the children would be in her class all day because the one-year-old classroom was short staffed a teacher.

Premises Not In Compliance

515 - Protected Openings Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

- (8) An opening to the outside shall be effectively protected against the entrance of vermin by:
- (a) Self-closing doors;
- (b) Closed windows;
- (c) Screening:
- (d) Controlled air current; or
- (e) Other effective means.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, it was found that the back door leading to the younger playground was propped open.

520 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, it was found that there was observed to be chipped paint on the walls in the Toddler 2 classroom, Pre-K 2 classroom, Preschool 2 classroom and in the Two-year-old classroom. In the Toddler 2 classroom there was observed to be a substantial amount of black stains on the alphabet carpet. In the Pre-K 2 classroom there was observed to be several brown spill stains going down the wall. In the Preschool 2 room and Pre-K 1 room, the trim was observed to be pulling away from the wall. In the Two-year-old classroom there was observed to be dirt and debris all around the edges of the wall.

General: Based on Observation, it was found that there was a tear in the diaper changing pad in the Infant 2 classroom.

General: Based on Observation, it was found that there were several bottles of sunscreen that were not in a locked container or area in the Pre-K 1 classroom, Pre-K 2 classroom and in the Preschool 1 classroom

- 2. A firm crib mattress in good repair with a clean tight-fitted sheet that shall be changed:
 - a. Weekly; or
- b. Immediately if it is soiled or wet;

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, it was found that in the Toddler 1 classroom, two (2) of the cribs used for napping did not have tight-fitted sheets. The sheets were observed to be very loose and bunched together.

755 - Toys/Equipment/Furniture Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 11. Toys and Furnishings.

- (1) All toys, equipment, and furniture contacted by a child shall be:
- (a) Kept clean and in good repair; and
- (b) Free of peeling, flaking, or chalking paint.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, it was found that in the Two-year-old classroom there was one (1) grey pillow that contained several black stains. In the Kindergarten classroom there was a blue couch that had three (3) tears exposing the foam.

Findinas:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the facility had a thrid party transportation contract but it did not state that the thrid party agreed to abide by state transportation regulations.

Food Service

935 - Refrigerator Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 8. Kitchen Requirements.

- (4) A cold-storage facility used for storage of perishable food in a nonfrozen state shall:
- (a) Have an indicating thermometer or other appropriate temperature measuring device;
- (b) Be in a safe environment for preservation; and
- (c) Be forty (40) degrees Fahrenheit or below.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, it was found that there was no indicating thermometer in the refrigerator in the Toddler 1 classroom or in the Infant 1 classroom.

Children's Records

1075 - Enrollment Information

922 KAR 2:110. Section 3. Records. (1) A child-care center shall maintain:

- (b) A written record for each child:
- 1. Completed and signed by the child's parent;
- 2. Retained on file on the first day the child attends the child-care center; and
- 3. To contain:
- a. Identifying information about the child, which includes, at minimum, the child's name, address, and date of birth;
- b. Contact information to enable a person in charge to contact the child's:
- (i) Parent at the parent's home or place of employment;
- (ii) Family physician; and
- (iii) Preferred hospital;
- c. The name of each person who is designated in writing to pick-up the child;
- d. The child's general health status and medical history including, if applicable:
- (ii) Restriction on the child's participation in activities with specific instructions from the child's parent or health professional; and
- (iii) Permission from the parent for third-party professional services in the child-care center;
- e. The name and phone number of each person to be contacted in an emergency situation involving or impacting the child;
- f. Authorization by the parent for the child-care center to seek emergency medical care for the child in the parent's absence;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that a review of ten (10) children's files found that two (2) children's files did not have documentation of the preferred hospital. The dates of enrollment for the children were 06/2011 and 12/06/2016.

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation, it was found that the civil penalty notice issued on 02/08/2017 and 12/09/2016 was not posted in a conspicuous place or made available for public inspection.
