General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following;

- 1. An uncovered outlet in the block area located in the Pre-K Academy classroom,
- 2. A broom, dustpan and a small vacuum accessible to children in care. The items were stored next to a toilet in the restroom located in the Toddler #3 classroom.
- 3. A roll of toilet paper on the floor in the restroom used by school-age children.

- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 $\frac{1}{2}$) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

410 - Training

General: Based on review of documentation, and ECE-TRIS, one (1) staff hired on 7/15/2004 only completed ten (10) hours of Early Care and Education training. Additionally, six (6) staff (hire dates: 8/16/18, 11/26/18, 2/11/19, 2/13/19, and (2) 4/15/19) have yet to complete the six (6) hour orientation training.

415 - Driver Requirements Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 12. Transportation.

- (18) A driver of a vehicle transporting a child for a center shall:
- (a) Be at least twenty-one (21) years old;
- (b) Complete:
- 1. The background checks as described in 922 KAR 2:280; and
- 2. An annual check of the:
- a. Kentucky driver history records in accordance with KRS 186.018; or
- b. Driver history records through the state transportation agency that issued the driver's license;
- (c) Hold a current driver's license which has not been suspended or revoked during the last five (5) years; and
- (d) Not caused an accident which resulted in the death of a person.

Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation the child-care center failed to meet this regulation. Two (2) staff identified as drivers of the vehicle used to transport children to and from field trips did not have a Kentucky driving history record on file. The documentation presented for review was a driving record completed through a company called "Hire Right".

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found an accumulation of dust/ particles inside the overhead exhaust fan light shield in the restroom located in the Preschool #1 classroom. Additionally, the surveyor found excessive dust on a return vent located in the Pre-K Academy classroom.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following;

- 1. Areas of chipped and peeling paint on the wall in the Toddler #2 classroom.
- 2. Numerous dents and scuffs on the wall below the window in the Pre-Academy classroom.
- 3. A hole in the wall behind the door in the Young Preschool classroom.
- 4. an area of rough drywall patch on the wall behind the toilet located in the Toddler #3 restroom.
- 5. Three (3) areas of white stains on the indoor carpeting located in the indoor gym.

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found stains on an indoor area rug located in the Pre-K Academy classroom.

Findings:

General: Based on observation, the surveyor found the following;

- 1. A buildup of grime around the mouthpiece of a water fountain located in the Pre-K Academy classroom. The surveyor noted the water fountain was working during the observation. The staff person in charge stated the children do not use the water fountain.
- 2. An excessive amount of peeling paint on the wood climbing structure located on the Toddler playground.
