Interviews with staff found that after the child woke up from nap, he was observed standing at the sink with a paper towel on his chin. The staff in the room asked the child what he was doing and the child indicated that a scab had come off of his chin and it was bleeding. The staff person in the room stated she looked at the child's chin and it did not look concerning. When the child's parent came to pick him up that afternoon, the parent observed blood on the child's shirt and collarbone as she placed him in his car seat. The parent also observed a cut under the child's chin. The next day the facility was notified that the child had been taken for medical treatment and received five stitches to the injured area. Although there was some indication that child may have fallen on the playground causing the injury, the exact cause was unknown.
