## Findings:

Provider/Representative

General: Based on interview and record review, it was found that on 1/18/19 six (6) children ages eighteen to twenty-four (18-24) months old were left unsupervised in the Toddler II room during nap time. Interviews with staff found that the staff person in the Toddler II room left the room to take her lunch break while another staff person supervised the children during naptime. The director left the facility around 1:00 p.m. leaving the assistant director in charge. The assistant director went to the Toddler II room to inform the staff person giving breaks she could go to the Pre-K room once the Toddler II teacher came back from her break. Further interviews found that the staff person giving the breaks thought the assistant director was staying in the Toddler II room for the remainder of the Toddler II teacher's break and she was supposed to go on to the Pre-K room. The staff person then left the Toddler II room and went to the Pre-K room so that staff person could go home. It could not be determined if the assistant director left the classroom before or after the staff person left the Toddler II room. It was not identified that the children in the Toddler II room had been left unsupervised until the teacher in the Toddler II room returned to the facility from her break. An interview with the director found that they determined the children had been left unsupervised for approximately ten to fifteen (10-15) minutes. A review of staff time cards found that the Toddler II room or what time she left the Toddler II room. The assistant director clocked out for her break at 2:30 p.m. and returned at 3:30 p.m. A review of documents found that the facility reported the incident to the Division of Regulated Child Care on the same day as the incident.
