(c) Provide the cabinet access and information in the completion of the investigation pursuant to KRS 620.030(4) and (5).

Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, it was found that a staff person took a picture of a child in her care and posted the photo on social media. The child found a discarded, unused feminine product on the playground. The staff person took a picture of the child holding the item and captioned the photo with, "(Child) found a "treasure" on the playground", before posting the photo on Snapchat. The child's parent had signed a media release form; however, the release did not include posting photographs on any social media sites.
