General: Based on observation and interview, the surveyor found that the safety of the children was not maintained as a three-year-old child was observed to run out of the Preschool Classroom and through the hallway to the School-Age Classroom. The hallway is between the Pre-school Classroom and School-Age Classroom. Director and staff in the school-age classroom imediately noticed the the three-year-child and returned her to staff in the Pre-school Classroom. Upon interview, staff in the Pre-school Classroom confirmed that she did not notice the child leave the classroom as all of the children were running around the classroom and she was trying to get them to go to the table for an activity. The Director identified that the child was her niece and thinks she has to be with her all of the time.

- (14) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half (1 1/2) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

General: Based on review of documentation, review of ECE-TRIS, and interview, the surveyor found that a staff file (DOH: 5/9/16) contained documentation of the completion of only fourteen and a half (14.5) hours of annual training. Review of ECE-TRIS, found that only ten and a half (10.5) hours of annual training were documented. Upon interview, the Director stated she thought the staff member had completed the required fifteen (15) hours of annual training.
