Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and ECE-TRIS records, there was a staff person with a hire date of 8/13/01 who only had evidence of having completed three (3) horus of training for the 2016-2017 training year. This staff person is a Family Service Worker that also helps in the classroom by giving staff breaks. There was an additional Family Service worker with a hire date of 8/12/96 who also helps in the classroom when needed. This staff person only had evidence of having completed eight (8) hours of training for the 2016-2017 training year. A bus driver who has a hire date of 11/02/01 and will give staff breaks on occassion only had evidence of having completed 10.5 hours of training for the 2015-2016 training year. There was an additional staff person hired 2/29/16 who did not complete pediatric abusive head trauma training until 8/16/17. This training is required to be completed within the employees first year of employment.

General: Based on Observation, in the bathrooms located in Classrooms 7 and 8 there were small holes in the wall behind the toilet. An accumulation of dirt and grime was found on the wall behind the toilet in the Classroom 7. In the bathroom located in Classroom 4 there were water stains on the ceiling and the floor was sticky. There was also a very strong urine smell.
