- 1. One wall in Classroom #5 had three areas with torn wall paper. Clear tape had been placed over the areas in an attempt to repair. The staff person in charge stated that the classroom is not currently being used by the children due to low enrollment.
- 2. A wooden piece of trim on the wall in the main hallway was broken in two places and hanging loose.

A large climbing structure that contained a tunnel and a double slide had yellow caution tape wrapped all the way around it. The staff person in charge stated that a support post on the back side of the structure was cracked and broken. She wrapped the caution tape around the structure to prevent the children from using it until she an get the structure repaired.
