Interview revealed the children utilized the non-licensed room for thirty (30) minutes, Monday thru Friday. Also, interview revealed the room was licensed but was removed from the center's licensed space a few years ago.

General: Based on observation, a toddler child did not wash his hands after he was diapered in the toddlers' room. A toddler did not wash his hands after he ate lunch in the toddler 3's room. Two (2) preschool children did not wash their hands after they played outside.

General: Based on observation, there was an accumulation of dust on the ceiling air vent in the preschool 1 room. There was a basketball-size brown stain on the ceiling tile in the preschool 2 room.

There was excessive amount of white paint that chipped and flaked from the fence, which surrounded the air conditioning units located inside the fenced in playground.
