Infant: Based on observation and interview, three (3) discontinued crib evacuation kits were installed on three (3), 2011 cribs. The exposed metal corners of the discontinued evacuation kits were not covered and a child fell and hit her forehead on the corner of the metal frame on 03/08/12.
