The longest exposed cement block was approximately twelve (12) inches wide. A blue frame swing set had an anchored cement block above the pea gravel on the outdoor playground. The cement block was approximately three (3) feet wide. Grass had grown above the pea gravel in several areas on the outdoor playground. Tree roots were above the pea gravel under a blue frame swing set on the outdoor playground.
