(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1  $\frac{1}{2}$ ) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

(17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

General: Based on review of documentation, a caregiver hired on 5/24/22, had no training hours during her subsequent year of employment. Interview determined the caregiver was an existing staff person within child care.

General: Based on observation, a water bottle, drink cartons, bottle caps, a jacket, a shirt, a sock, and shorts were scattered on the outdoor play area.

#### **Findings**

General: Based on observation, an approximate three (3) foot wide concrete block, which secured a blue swing set to the ground, had sharp edges and was raised approximately two (2) inches above the pea gravel on the outdoor play area. Tall weeds had grown above the pea gravel in several areas in the outdoor play area. Several tree roots were raised approximately three (3) inches above the pea gravel. The longest tree root was approximately four (4) feet long. The tree roots created a tripping hazard in the outdoor play area.
