General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. The surveyor found no written verification of a staff's (DOH: 8/26/19) educational requirements. Through interview, staff reported written verification was not available for review.
- 2. The surveyor found no written verification of four (4) staff's (DOH: 6/8/2020) educational requirements. Through interview, staff reported written verification was not available for review.
- 3. The surveyor found no written verification of a staff's (DOH: 6/15/2020) educational requirements. Through interview, staff reported written verification was not available for review.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

- 1. No written verification was found that a staff (DOH: 6/15/2020) obtained a negative tuberculin result or a statement from a health professional that the individual is free from active tuberculosis. Through interview, a staff reported that a test result or health professional's statement was not available for review.
- 2. Written verification was found that a staff (DOH: 6/8/2020) obtained a tuberculin test; however, the test results were not documented. Through interview, staff reported that the test result was not available for review.

Upon opening the door, the surveyor found that a gallon of bleach was stored on the floor. A staff person confirmed that the children walk by the mechanical room daily. The bleach was within reach and accessible to the children

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found that a child's (DOE: 6/4/2020) verification of immunization did not have an expiration date. Staff reported that additional verification of the child's immunization was not available for review. Therefore, the surveyor was unable to determine if the child's immunizations were current.
