General: Based on review of documentation presented, the surveyor learned that:

- 1. Staff member's (DOH: 05/17/21) file did not have the central registry background check. 2. Staff member's (DOH: 05/26/21) file did not have the central registry background check.
- 3. Staff member's (DOH: 05/25/21) file did not have the central registry background check.
- 4. Staff member's (DOH: 08/19/20) file did not have the central registry background check. 5. Staff member's (DOH: 03/19/21) file did not have the central registry background check.
- 6. Staff member's (DOH: 06/08/20) file did not have the central registry background check.

Therefore, the center did not have the required completed background checks for six (6) staff members. The surveyor did not witness any of the staff members working alone while completing the survey. During interview, staff stated that the six (6) staff members have not worked alone in the classroom(s) with the children. The surveyor did see documentation in the staff members' files where the background checks had been requested.

Also, without having the completed background checks, the children's health and safety was compromised.

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (a) Hired after January 1, 2009, who have supervisory power over a minor and are not enrolled in secondary education, shall have a:
- 1. High school diploma:
- 2. GED or qualifying documentation from a comparable educational entity; or
- 3. Commonwealth Child Care Credential as described in 922 KAR 2:250;

General: Based on review of documentation presented, the surveyor learned that a staff (DOH: 05/17/21) member's file did not contain a high school diploma, GED, or Commonwealth Child Care Credential. During interview, staff confirmed the documentation was not obtained for the staff's file.

395 - TB Verification **Not In Compliance**

922 KAR 2:090. Section 11. Staff Requirements.

- (1) Child-care center staff:
- (b) Shall provide, prior to employment and every two (2) years thereafter:
- 1. A statement from a health professional that the individual is free of active tuberculosis; or
- 2. A copy of negative tuberculin results.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation presented, the surveyor learned:

- 1. A staff's (DOH: 05/17/21) negative tuberculin result was no longer current as of 01/26/19. During interview, staff stated they did not have a new tuberculin result for this staff member.
- 2. A staff's (DOH: 03/19/21) file did not contain a copy of a negative tuberculin result or a statement from a health professional that the individual was free of active tuberculosis. During interview, staff stated they were not aware that the information was not in the file.

- (5) The building shall be constructed to ensure the:

- b. Shielded or have shatter-proof bulbs installed; and
- (b) Following are protected:
- 1. Windows;
- 2. Doors;
- 3. Stoves:
- 4. Heaters;
- 5. Furnaces;
- 6. Pipes; and
- 7. Stairs.

Findings:

General: Based on observation during a tour of the center, the surveyor found dead bugs in the ceiling light fixtures in the boy's and girl's restrooms located in Classroom #1. During interview, staff stated they would have maintenance clean the fixtures.

General: Based on review of documentation presented, the surveyor found a child's (DOE: 03/15/20) file contained an immunization certificate that was no longer current as of 05/17/21. Staff reported this was the most recent immunization certificate that was provided to the center.

General: Based on review of documentation presented, the surveyor learned that the Emergency Preparedness Plan did not contain information or instruction on how the center would inform parents on reunification of children with parents would take place. During interview, staff stated they would update the information in the Emergency Preparedness
