### Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, the surveyor found the following:

Staff's (DOH: 05/08/2012) file did not contain a copy of a statement from a health professional stating that the individual was free of active tuberculosis or a copy of a negative tuberculin (TB skin test) results for the staff person; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if the staff person was free of active tuberculosis.
- 2. Staff's (DOH: 03/01/2022) file did not contain a copy of a statement from a health professional stating that the individual was free of active tuberculosis or a copy of a negative tuberculin (TB skin test) results for the staff person; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if the staff person was free of active tuberculosis.
- 3. Staff's (DOH: 05/17/2021) file did not contain a copy of a statement from a health professional stating that the individual was free of active tuberculosis or a copy of a negative tuberculin (TB skin test) results for the staff person; therefore, the surveyor was unable to verify if the staff person was free of active tuberculosis.

Staff reported that she would have a copy of a statement or a TB skin test for all staff.

- 3. There was a plastic water bottle located on the playground close to the fence.
- 4. There was what appeared to be a hard plastic scattered throughout the playground.

Staff reported that she would clean the debris off the playground.
