- (16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:
- (a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation completed within the first three (3) months of employment in a child-care program;
- (b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and
- (c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training completed between July 1 and the following June 30 of each subsequent year of employment in a child care program, including one and one-half (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.
- (17) A staff person's compliance with training requirements of this section shall be verified through the cabinet-designated database maintained pursuant to 922 KAR 2:240.

### Findings:

General: Based on observation and review of documentation, this regulatory requirement was not met. The following was found:

- 1. A staff member hired on 8/14/2014, did not complete the fifteen hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training between 7/01/2020 and 6/30/2021. The staff member completed three hours of training. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.
- 2. A staff member hired on 10/17/2016, did not complete the fifteen hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training between 7/01/2020 and 6/30/2021. The staff member completed 8.50 hours of training. The ECE-TRIS system was reviewed.
