- 2. Proof of educational qualifications;
- 3. Record of annual performance evaluation;
- 4. Documentation of compliance with tuberculosis screening in accordance with Section 11(1)(b) of this administrative regulation; and
- 5. The results of background checks conducted in accordance with 922 KAR 2:280;

Findings:

General: Based on Review of Documentation and interview, a staff, hired on 03/09/18; a staff, hired on 03/07/18, and a staff, hired on 02/20/18, each did not have proof a child abuse/neglect check was submitted timely.

922 KAR 2:120. Section 3. General Requirements.

- (7) The following shall be inaccessible to a child in care:
- (a) Toxic cleaning supplies, poisons, and insecticides;
- (b) Matches, cigarettes, lighters, and flammable liquids; and
- (c) Personal belongings and medications of staff.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, a caregiver's purse was on the floor beside an adult desk in the two-year-olds' room. A caregiver's coat hung on a hook among children's coats in the three-year-olds' room. A can of disinfectant spray was stored accessible to children in a compartment under the diapering station in the two-year-olds' room. These items were accessible to children.

580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Premises Requirements.

(9) Floors, walls, and ceilings shall be smooth, in good repair, and constructed to be easily cleaned.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, dark circular stains were on two (2) ceiling tiles in room A203 and on two (2) ceiling tiles in the three and a half to four-year-olds' room. Dark circular stains were on four (4) ceiling tiles in the pre-k room. Interview determined the center's roof was damaged due to recent weather.

General: Based on Observation, a tear was in the surface of the diapering mat in the two-year-olds' room.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, ten (10) children's coats touched as they hung on coat hooks in the three and a half to four-year-olds' room. In addition, children's coats touched as they hung on coat hooks in the three-year-olds' and pre-k rooms.

795 - Individual Bed/Mat/Cot and Bedding

922 KAR 2:120. Section 6. Sleeping and Napping Requirements.

- (3) Rest time shall include adequate space specified by the child's age as follows:
- (b) For a toddler or preschool-age child:
- 1. An individual bed, a two (2) inch thick waterproof mat, or cot in good repair; and
- 2. Bedding that is in good repair and is changed:
- a. Weekly; or
- b. Immediately if it is soiled or wet.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, two (2) red and blue nap mats were torn and had exposed foam in the two-year-olds' room.

800 - Twelve Inch Spacing Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 6. Sleeping and Napping Requirements.

(6) Cots, equipment, and furnishings used for sleeping and napping shall be spaced twelve (12) inches apart to allow free and safe movement by a person.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, an infant slept in a crib that touched another crib in the infants' room; therefore, the cribs were not 12 inches apart.

815 - Toys/Furniture Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 11. Toys and Furnishings.

- (1) All toys and furniture contacted by a child shall be:
- (a) Kept clean and in good repair; and
- (b) Free of peeling, flaking, or chalking paint.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, safety belts were missing from two (2) highchairs in the infants' room.

- (c) Be forty (40) degrees Fahrenheit or below.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the thermometer registered forty-five (45) degrees Fahrenheit in the refrigerator in the kitchen.

1030 - Frozen Food Not In Compliance

922 KAR 2:120. Section 8. Kitchen Requirements.

- (5) Frozen food shall be:
- (a) Kept at a temperature of zero degrees Fahrenheit or below; and
- (b) Thawed:
- 1. At refrigerator temperatures;
- 2. Under cool, potable running water;
- 3. As part of the cooking process; or
- 4. By another method in accordance with the Department of Public Health's food safety standards and permits, established in KRS Chapter 217.

Findings:

General: Based on Observation, the thermometer registered ten (10) degrees Fahrenheit in the deep freezer in the kitchen.
