(16) In accordance with KRS 199.896(15) and (16), a staff person with supervisory authority over a child shall complete the following:

(a) Six (6) hours of cabinet-approved orientation within the first three (3) months of employment;

(b) Nine (9) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training within the first year of employment, including one and one-half $(1 \frac{1}{2})$ hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training; and

(c) Fifteen (15) hours of cabinet-approved early care and education training during each subsequent year of employment, including one and onehalf (1 ½) hours of cabinet-approved pediatric abusive head trauma training completed once every five (5) years.

Findings:

General: Based on review of documentation, a caregiver hired on 10/26/18, lacked one and a half (1 1/2) hours of training.

Three (3) light fixtures had dead bugs located in the three-year-olds' room. A light fixture, located in the hallway near the elevator, was not shielded and had no shatter proof bulbs. 580 - Floors, Walls, Ceilings **Not In Compliance** 922 KAR 2:120. Section 4. Findings: General: Based on observation, two (2) ceiling tiles had brown circles in pre-k room #2. (2) A toilet room shall: (a) 1. Be provided for each gender; or 2. General: Based on observation, weeds had grown above the rubber mulch on the older children's outdoor playground. The weeds were approximately eight (8) inches tall.
