General: Based on observation and interview, an excessive amount of grass was spread throughout the protective surface on the outside playground. Plastic weed block was raised two (2) inches above the protective surface and caused a trip hazard throughout the outdoor playground.

## Findings:

General: Based on interview and review of documentation, two (2) children enrolled 10/14/20, a child enrolled on 08/26/21, and two (2) children enrolled 12/03/19, did not have health information pertaining to allergies on file. A child enrolled 08/26/21 and a child enrolled on 10/10/21, did not have information on file to enable the person in charge to contact the child's preferred hospital. In addition, a child enrolled 08/26/21, did not have information on file to enable the person in charge to contact the child's physician.

Written Documentation Not In Compliance

- (b) Documented.

## Findings:

General: Based on observation, interview and review of documentation, monthly fire drills were conducted in June, July, August, September, October, November, and December of 2021, but documentation was not available for review. In addition, quarterly earthquake and tornado drills was conducted in the second, third, and fourth quarters 2021 and first quarter 2022, but documentation was not available for review. A lockdown drill was conducted in the fourth quarter of 2021, but documentation was not available for review.
