Findings:

General: Based on observation and interview, a child received an injury to the left thumb at approximately 10:15am on 3-16-21. Interview determined the child held on to a shelf while swinging her leg back and forth. The shelf fell on the child's left thumb which caused the nail to detach from the thumb. The nail was reattached and the child received eight (8) stitches. Also the thumb bone chipped at the tip which required the child to wear a splint. The shelf was not secured to the wall which compromised the health and safety of a child.
